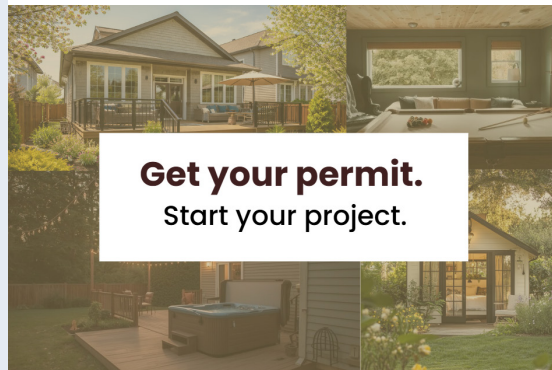


## Review your property assessment before March 31

## Looks like ice. Not safe ice.

Stormwater facilities are **never safe** for skating or winter play, no matter how solid they appear.

Water can keep moving underneath from snowmelt, runoff and road salting, quickly thinning the ice and creating hidden weak spots. Water levels can also change suddenly. Stay safe and stay off stormwater facilities.
